NOBLES VINEYARD, FORT ROSS-SEAVIEW, SONOMA COUNTY

Coastal Pinot Noir from a family vineyard located near the historic Fort Ross, an early Russian coastal settlement dating from 1812, the vineyard lies on the interior of the second ridge from the Pacific Ocean. Marine sedimentary soils. From historic Calera clone selection.

Dark fruit aromas of cherry and blackberry with accents of sassafras, damp earth, wood spice, and forest mushroom. Subtle notes of toasted oak support the frame. In the mouth brighter notes of citrus and cranberry elevate the delivery. Youthful and compact at release. 11 barrels produced.
