Greetings from the hills above Sonoma

2025 marks our 20th full harvest from the home ranch here in the Moon Mountain District. It's hard to fathom that the majority of our vines are from the original plantings. But you can see it—their trunks are as thick as a person's thigh and they have thick fibrous paper-like bark that peels off as each season's new growth emerges.

Looking out from the terrace over the vineyards, the winter rains have brought their

springtime renewal to the hillside. The bright green rows of vines are dotted with orange calendula, yellow mustard, and purple and white spring pea flowers that glisten on a clear morning. Soon, the yearly cycle will begin again, with buds emerging from the new vine growth as the days and nights warm.

On the Sonoma estate, we are planting more clones of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc as we continue to redevelop some of the Amapola Creek vineyards that Richard Arrowood planted years ago. We are also adding a few acres in very rocky ground on the northwest side of the estate. This volcanic, mineral-rich soil is ideal for the full-bodied, intensely aromatic wines we are most interested in producing. These plantings will help us continue to bring you the most diverse, flavorful wines from our Moon Mountain Estate long into the future.

We've had incredible vintages the past two years; it puts a smile on your face and joy in your heart when everything comes together to create superlative wines. This year, we have a number of new releases, with the latest vintage of the Estate Grown Cabernet Sauvignon for our Cabernet Society members. We're pleased to share several new releases from diverse vineyards with our Pinot lovers in the Grand Cru club, including the newer Elswick Vineyard from Anderson Valley, as well as the perennial favorite from the Nobles Vineyard in Fort Ross–Seaview. And the Wise-Guys will appreciate the latest Wisdom and the Estate Grown Syrah and Petite Sirah in their shipments.

As always, we invite you to visit us in northern California any time of year. We look forward to tasting these new wines with you as you experience the beauty of wine country.

Wishing you health and happiness—may you have many joyous moments with wine and friends this year.

TRIOS – CAB. SAUV. MOON MOUNTAIN AVA SONOMA VALLEY ESTATE GROWN 2021

Red cherry and red raspberry fruits lead the aromas. Undertones of red licorice, star anise, vanilla, and nutmeg spice. Further notes of red earth and mineral accent the fruits. Medium to full bodied, fine tannins provide pleasing texture and a dry finish. BLEND: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Syrah, 5% Cabernet Franc, 2% Tannat.

Dark blueberry and blackberry fruits integrated with black pepper, fresh ground coffee, violets, nutmeg, and vanilla notes. Seamless and bright in the mouth with freshness and complexity. Reveals a pinpoint texture and has an extended finish. A perfect wine for steak. BLEND: 94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Cabernet Franc, 3% Syrah.

Our estate-grown Syrah leads with aromas of fresh red cherry and raspberry. Notes of citrus, olive, pepper, cured meats, and red earth support the fruit. Toasty oak flavors integrate seamlessly in this complex wine. Juicy and fresh in the mouth with a long, caressing finish.

Mega dark, almost black color. Huge raspberry fruits waft from the glass, entwined with notes of red licorice, jasmine flowers, candied lemon, mint, and chaparral. A soft entry with velvety tannins and a kiss of oak in the finish. Medium dry with touches of mineral.

In the nose, the Wisdom Proprietary Red Blend shows brambly red fruits, with nuances of No. 2 pencil shavings, red and white ground pepper, and a touch of oak that support the fruit. Juicy in the mouth with a touch of spice. BLEND: 72% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Zinfandel, 5% Syrah, 2% Petit Verdot
