Greetings from our Estate on Moon Mountain

Spring renewal has come once again to our home here in the California wine country and the vineyards are lush with their cover crops and the bright notes of the multi-colored mustards and orange calendula flowers. These are sometimes punctuated by the small herds of sheep who help us keep the grass and weeds trimmed. The air is fresh and the sky clear as the days grow longer. A liveliness enters our step.

The 2023 wine grape growing season in Sonoma and Napa was notably cooler than some recent years. The winter and spring rains replenished soil moisture in the vineyards and the cool weather pushed budbreak later than usual. Summer stayed relatively mild, without major heat spikes, allowing grapes to ripen gradually and evenly. As a result, harvest began several weeks later than normal in most places, and in some vineyards extended well into November. At this measured pace, our vineyards produced excellent fruit quality, with balanced sugars, bright acidity, and well-developed flavors. 2023 was a classic, high-quality vintage that may rival the great vintages of the last 30 years, such as 2007 and 2013.

This spring, we are releasing several wines from this exceptional vintage. From the Estate, be sure to look for the new release of the 2023

Petite Sirah. For our Pinot Noir enthusiasts, we have three new releases of 2023 wines from our vineyards near the coast. Of particular note is the Nobles Vineyard Fort Ross–Seaview Pinot; if you've enjoyed the Nobles in the past, this one is not to be missed. For Cabernet Sauvignon, we are bringing out some fun Napa Valley vintages from our library, as well as the 2023 Moon Mountain Estate Cabernet.

We thrive on your interest and support of our independent, hand-made wines; it's a joy to be able to share them with you. Please drop us a note; we're always interested in hearing about your experience and how the wines are tasting for you.

We want to extend an invitation to you, on your next visit to the Napa Valley, to come see us at our newest location in Oakville, home to our Mark Herold Winery. Here, you can explore the latest vintages of these wines and also experience a tasting of B. Wise wines. ANDERSON VALLEY
MENDOCINO COUNTY
ELSWICK VINEYARD
2023

From the cool, deep end of the Anderson Valley, this vineyard is within a few miles of the fresh marine air of the Pacific Ocean, enjoying ample sunlight perched above the Navarro River. These conditions produce elegantly structured Pinot Noir with depth and concentration and a fresh acidity that balances the darker fruit flavors and aromatics.

The 2023 release shows black cherry and plum fruit aromas and flavors with hints of saffras, flint, and pine. Further nuances of morel mushroom and forest floor envelop the mouth. Balanced moderate tannins give texture and roundness.

FORT ROSS—SEAVIEW
SONOMA COUNTY
NOBLES VINEYARD
2023

This coastal Pinot Noir comes from a stunning vineyard owned by the Nobles family. Located on the crest of a remote ridge ten miles from the Pacific, sea shells can be seen in the marine sedimentary soils. And while this region of Goldridge soils has seen a recent surge of interest, the Nobles vines are older, planted nearly 45 years ago from heritage selections that preceded modern clones.

A classic Nobles Pinot Noir, the 2023 shows aromas of cranberry and pomegranate fruits accented by cola, earth, and tarragon notes. The texture is silky and evocative, medium-dry with an extended finish.

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY
SONOMA COUNTY
SILVER EAGLE VINEYARD
2023

From an undulating plateau located between the Pacific Ocean and the Russian River, the Silver Eagle vineyard is planted with Vosne-Romanée, Calera, and Swan clones. The soils here are a Goldridge and red shale mix, perfect for balancing explosive fruit flavors with minerality.

Aromas and flavors of red fruits—raspberry and strawberry—lift from the glass, with underlying notes and secondary aromas of white pepper, fern, and rosemary. The 2023 release shows a rich, glycerin-filled texture that caresses the mouth, finishing with light to medium tannins.
